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## **School Membership Policies**

The Museum of Idaho will offer school memberships to any public or private area school to help build a culture of lifelong learners and museum goers as well as to supplement curriculum and to help teachers and students dive deep into project and place based learning. Schools wishing to participate in this program agree to the following:

- The cost of the school membership will be \$6 multiplied by the number of students in the school. Chaperones receive free admission. (If there are 400 students enrolled in your school, the cost of a membership would be \$2400.00). *This price was calculated based upon the fact that the MOI hosts at least two traveling exhibits per year and the cost for a student visit is regularly \$3 per student and per chaperone.*
- Classes visiting the Museum of Idaho using a school membership are welcome to visit as many times as they are able throughout the period of membership (one year), but they MUST schedule their visit with the Volunteer and Visitor Services Coordinator at (208) 522-1400 ext. 3009, prior to arriving. Failure to do so will result in denied entry.
- Classes are expected to provide at least one chaperone per six students in grades preK-5 and at least one chaperone per ten students in grades 6-12 unless otherwise arranged with the Volunteer and Visitor Services Coordinator. It is the role of the chaperones to ensure that students are acting appropriately in the museum. *(Encourage students to slow down and look at the exhibits instead of running; encourage them to talk about what they are seeing, but do so with inside voices; encourage them to ask questions and engage with what they are seeing in a respectful manner; make sure they do not have food, gum, candy, or drinks inside of the galleries.)*
- Students must follow all other MOI Field Trip Policies which will be sent to teachers after they book a field trip. Visiting classes must present a valid school ID that matches the name of the school on the membership in order to ensure that the membership is being used only by representatives of the membership holding school. The membership can only be used for students currently enrolled in the school that is named on file. The Museum of Idaho will keep a digital record of schools that have purchased membership. No membership card is required once the membership is approved.
